

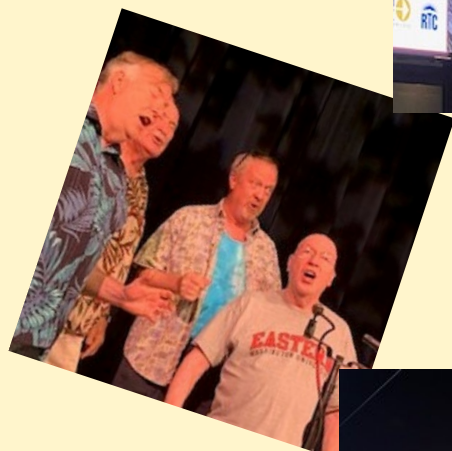


Triumphant Return!
